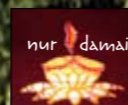
Father Sebastian, a Jesuit priest from India and reputed Asian theologian, is a wonderful spiritual teacher. He is the author of various notable books such as *The Spiritual Journey* and *The Power of Silence*. It was his dream to "have a place where followers of different religions could assemble with joy and not with fear, with openness and not with suspicion." In 1986 this dream was realized when he founded Sameeksha Ashram in Kalady, South India, a quiet place of prayer open to all in search of spiritual truth. He has been keenly engaged for many years in spiritual ministries and inter-religious dialogue in Europe as well as Asia. Many people from diverse faith traditions have been deeply inspired by the authority, depth and eloquence of his teaching and the integrity, gentleness and humility of his person.
